Front vent for securing headlamp


Side attachment piece

To Remove Ear Pieces

(1.) Use Allen Wrench with philips screw driver end to remove screws holding ear pieces in place.

(2.) Remove plastic ear piece from helmet.

(3.) If ear pieces are wanted but you do not want your ears covered, the foam ear piece can also be removed by slipping it out from the padding.





To Attach Visor

(1.) Use Allen Wrench to unscrew side attachment piece.

(2.) Align visor so holes line up to attachment point on helmet and use the Allen Wrench to screw into place (visor will not be flush to helmet).

(3.) Visor should be able to move from top of helmet over eyes easily.



To Secure Headlamp

(1.) Attach headlamp strap onto helmet by placing clips in front two vents of helmet (2.) Attach headlamp to back clip and secure onto the front with the headlamp strap. (3.) Visor and headlamp cannot be worn at the same time. **OR**,

(1.) Attach headlamp strap onto helmet by sliding the clips through the front two vents so the strap sits on the inside of the helmet (2.) Attach headlamp to back clip of helmet and secure on to the front with attaching the clips to the headlamp.
